NOTICE

This is a notification to all homeowners who have a suite in their home or an additional living space on their property.

Beginning November 1st, 2025 all suites will be billed at .5 the monthly rate for Water and/or Sewer Service.

This increase is to account for the increased demand on our Sewer Treatment System and our Water Treatment System.

We are also asking that you provide a contact number for your tenants in case of any emergencies, (water or sewer line breaks, fire etc.) that may happen.

IMPORTANT REMINDER TO ALL SLE RESIDENTS

Sprinkling Restrictions are in place from May 15 to September 15.

Users may water from 6 am to 10 am and from 6 pm to 10 pm on the appropriate day.

EVEN NUMBERED HOUSES MAY WATER ON EVEN NUMBERED DAYS.

ODD NUMBERED HOUSES MAY WATER ON ODD NUMBERED DAYS.

Automatic watering systems should be programmed to operate between 12 am and 6 am on the appropriate day.

Failure to comply with the above restrictions may result in a fine and/or termination of water service.

BLIND BAY CITIZENS PATROL NEED YOU!

We are a small dedicated group of volunteers helping to keep the community safe, Operating under the guidelines of the RCMP volunteer program. Due to personal and medical conditions the active membership is currently 6. This limits our ability to service the area and therefore we need to recruit additional members and someone who would like to lead the organization forward.

BE THE EXTRA EYES FOR THE RCMP

As our community grows, so does the need for safety. Volunteering just a couple of hours a month on your own schedule can make a big difference.

- Patrol with a partner for just 1 shift, about 2 hours, per month from May to September. You may patrol in other months as well.
- Stipend is made at the end of each year to reimburse for fuel.
- Join our Speed Watch team to help reduce speeding in our neighbourhoods in addition to patrols.
- You set your own schedule.

The flag of British Columbia is based upon the shield of the provincial arms of British Columbia. At the top of the flag is a rendition of the Royal Union Flag, defaced in the centre by a crown, while the bottom of the flag features a setting sun over stylized waves, representing British Columbia's connection to the Pacific Ocean and its westernmost location in Canada.

Originally, the arms featured the Union Flag on the bottom. This was changed as it conflicted with the expression "The sun never sets on the British Empire". Based upon a revised design, the flag of British Columbia was re-introduced on June 14, 1960, by Premier W. A. C. Bennett, and was first flown on board the BC Ferries motor vessel *Sidney* (later *Queen of Sidney*).
